Bounce Back

Brixton based Bounce Back is a social enterprise and Registered Charity that supports offenders by providing training and employment in painting and decorating during their last year of imprisonment. The goal of the programme is to help the individuals grow confidence in their social skills and employability. This effectively reduces re-offending rates by ensuring post sentence employment.

Bounce Back builds teams of professional painters and decorators from participants that have passed through the training programme and more than 2,000 individuals have gained qualifications with the organisation. Supplied as subcontractors on construction contracts, in the past year alone, Bounce Back painters and decorators have seen 110 completed jobs.

Working on behalf of JP Morgan Chase Foundation, Newable has been delivering the Get Ready to Supply programme for 4 years. The programme connects small construction companies in East and Inner London to huge construction projects in the Capital.

Bounce Back registered onto Get Ready to Supply in April 2016. Francesca Findlater, the founder and CEO of Bounce Back invited us to Brixton Prison where we were able to see the work Bounce Back does first hand. Francesca had ambitions to extend Bounce Back's training services to female prisons; however, she lacked the funds to be able to do so.

Following this, Newable were able to nominate Bounce Back for a grant with the Third House Trust. Our team supported Francesca with her application, which was successful, and Bounce Back attained £12,500 for their new Women in Construction initiative.
